


## Ball River Drowning Names, Details, Responders

## Judge Restores Status to Veteran Graduates Justice Involved Vets Find Second Chance in Veterans Court

The growing need for targeted and effective recovery communities was evident at the Monroe County Justice Center last week on Wednesday.

A dozen military veterans - men and women from five counties between the ages of 25 and 65 - appeared before Judge Dwaine Thomas, a commencement underway to mark graduation from Monroe County Veterans Court.

"You've come a long way," Vet to Vet Tennessee mentor coordinator Randy Scott said. "We commend your dedication. If you ever need anyone to talk to, call Vet to Vet anytime, even on weekends."



Hartline slipped during a jump and fell into the water and failed to surface.

Responding agencies included Monroe County EMS, Hopewell Fire Department, Turkey Creek Fire Department, US Forest Service Law Enforcement, Monroe County Rescue Squad, and Monroe County Sheriff's Dive Team.

Vet to Vet mentors and McNabb Military Center therapist Travis Miller in learning to understand and treat root causes of addiction and impulsive behaviors.

"Each of you made a decision to sign a contract giving your life for this country," Miller said. "When you joined this program you made that decision to fight for yourselves."

According to Judge Thomas, a majority of the

voluntary participants in Veterans Court were identified by sheriff's deputies and law enforcement. When they're caught breaking the law they're arrested and booked and jailed like anyone else.

The arresting deputy or officer then alerts the court of a veteran who needs assistance.

Vet to Vet Tennessee steps in. Mentors offer to work with the justice-involved veteran through the judicial process and recovery, solving problems and hurdles and offering support as an advocate.

Many of the mentors - not all - have been through Veterans Court and decided to help the next person down the line.

Each one volunteering to repay what Thomas calls a "debt of honor," a commitment to fight for the people who have fought for our country and our way of life.

"This court is a restitution this country owes its veterans," Thomas said.

Veterans Court not only offers treatment and recovery. It gives participants a chance at a clean

slate, a chance to start over, a chance to restore their status as a productive citizen.

Once the program is completed - six months, at times longer, a year, more if needed - a commencement in Veterans Court rewards growth with an official judicial expungement. If the veteran is from another county, Thomas recommends his or her presiding judge do the same.

Take for example Nicholas Oswald, a Polk County veteran arrested three years ago in May.

A former MP - or Military Police - Oswald said he had bonded with fentanyl, formed an addiction to the substance that led to an arrest and conviction for possession of Schedule II.

Veterans Court pre-

sented the possibility to begin anew. Oswald said he hoped to retain a good job, clear his record, become a better person, "not rot in Polk County for three years."

Telling his story, Oswald said he learned about veterans court but his file was lost for almost a year between counties. In that time, he joined Celebrate Recovery, found sobriety, and worked so he wouldn't "have to live the way I was living."

Eventually he paired with a Vet to Vet mentor, Michael McGraill. Oswald told the court he wanted to become a mentor. He was willing to serve someone else, growing the Vet to Vet brotherhood by one person willing to reach someone and teach someone how to make it through life.

Perhaps it was mentor Bob Goguen who captured the spirit of the court.

"You are God's perfect creation," he said to a graduate, "and He's not done with you yet."

In order for Veterans Court to provide the support and service our veterans deserve, it asks for involvement from a great big team of caring people.

County Veteran Service Officer Andy Boyd, "the best VSO in the world," according to mayor Mitch Ingram, whose office and

staff actively advocate for and serve local veterans.

Sheriff Tommy Jones, his office and deputies identify veterans in the criminal justice system.

Administrative assistant Beverly Powell, termed "indispensable" by Thomas to facilitate proceedings.

Judge Dwaine Thomas, doesn't take credit for outcomes, helped establish Veterans Court in Monroe County, advocates for its principles and participants.

McNabb Military Center, specially trained military services therapists assisting individuals with post-traumatic stress disorder, depression, anxiety, substance use, co-occurring disorders, thoughts of suicide, and other invisible wounds incurred from service, regardless of discharge status.

And Vet to Vet Tennessee mentors, (Thomas: "program doesn't work without mentors"), experience, empathy, encouragement, "someone who cares," "tough love," camaraderie, brotherhood, understanding.



## Planning

Creek Investments - regarding annexation of 78.69 acres of property adjacent to Isbill Road.

City planner Laura Smith said a public hearing for the matter was set for 5 p.m. on August 11 just before the regular meeting of mayor and board of aldermen.

Moving on, the body inspected a subdivision plat for six lots on 6.05 acres on Hiwassee Road and Short Bark Road, applicants Kaleb and Chelsey Forbes.

One official said public water would be provided within the subdivision. A motion was approved to accept the plat subject to septic system approval and obtaining water certification.

The planning commission next approved a subdivision plat for Kelly's Acres on Steele Lane, roughly 20 acres, Kelly Eaton property owner. Approval was granted on the condition all proper notifications were obtained, including the identification of the actual property owner.

Another plat involved

16 lots of residential property at Pedigo Fields. Chairman James Lee recused himself but said the plat had been preliminarily approved on August 20 last year.

Smith said four lots with easements were part of the property and sewer and water certification had been obtained. Approval was contingent on changes made to the property be shown on the plat.

Donnie and Ronnie Atchley requested a variance for the existing 20-foot-wide private easement and drive for two lots on Dyer Road, the property 1.3 acres inside the city planning region.

"They're just trying to get it squared up for their family," Mayor Scott Hunt said, and the plat and variance were approved.

And the final subdivision application came from Robert G. Campbell and Associates, property owner CMH Homes Inc, for Walnut Reserve at Bailey Lane. It involved 48 lots, two detention areas, two new roads (Unicoi Gate Road and Unicoi Trail Road) on 20.63 acres of residential property.

A preliminary plat was approved on May 21 last

year and the planning commission granted approval of the final plat.

In other business, Sharon Davis appeared before the body on behalf of True Purpose Ministries, located at 225 Wayman Road, to address a road in the area.

"It's just an old road," Lee said.

"What if all three property owners agree it's an access road?" Brad Hunt asked.

"Let's see what your attorney says," Lee said, advising Davis to contact the city attorney through counsel.

The body granted a variance request involving a private easement to property owner Verlin Bowers.

And a city resident told planning commissioners a planned subdivision involving 232 homes had the potential to seriously increase traffic on Isbill Road.

"It's a minor speedway," he said. "Nobody follows the speed limits there. A lot of foot traffic. A lot of bicycle traffic. We all know the road is not up to specs."

"We asked for a road study," Casey Davis said. "It hasn't been done yet."
